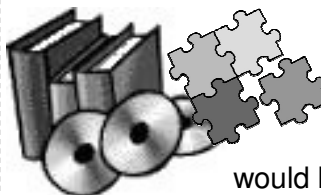
Why not come and join the BROWNIES?
