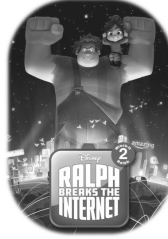

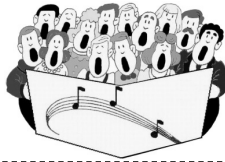

- Change, Heal and Always be Mentally Prepared -

This community learning course looks into awareness of mental health through increasing self-awareness, awareness of stress, anxiety, depression and looking into positive coping strategies. Learners can use this personally or as a starting block for a new career in Mental Health or well-being.

The course is 15 hours long and will run one day a week for 3 weeks, 2nd, 9th and 16th May from 9:30am - 2:30pm. You will be eligible if you are a County Durham resident, over the age of 19 and willing to dedicate your time to learning.

This course is designed for any learner that wants to raise their awareness of mental health and the problems that can cause mental ill-health and develop coping strategies. Or you may want to start a new career path.

Course Content: Self awareness, awareness of stress, awareness of anxiety, awareness of depression, positive coping strategies.
