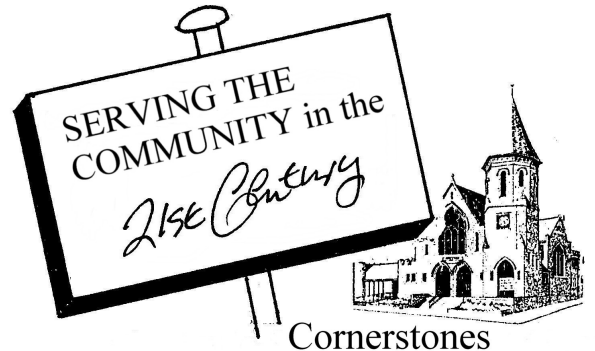

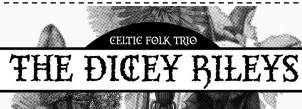
Sincere apologies but the incorrect telephone number was given in this notice last week. The correct number is now given below.
